USING UPLIFT AS A WORKING ADULT



Across the world, project leaders are driving teams dedicated to preserving the health of our planet's ecosystems. Pioneering companies like Apara Global are spearheading this crucial initiative.

While visiting a rural school near her hometown, she noticed students wearing school jerseys with no shirts, which inspired her to create Apara Global, a fashion and retail company dedicated to sustainability through recycling waste into clothing.

Born in South Africa, Ayanda recognizes the country's significant contribution to marine pollution, with thousands of tons of plastic entering the ocean annually.

In response, Apara Global aligns itself with the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals 14.1 and 6.3, which aim to reduce marine pollution. Ayanda also emphasizes the importance of project management skills in achieving sustainable projects
